Chase County Commissioner Meeting August 23, 2022

The regular meeting of the Chase County Board of Commissioners was called to order at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 23, 2022. Present were board members Jacci Brown, Duane Dinnel, Dennis Kunnemann; county clerk Debra Clark, road superintendent Toney Krajewski and deputy county attorney Rory Roundtree.

Notice of the meeting had been advertised in the Imperial Republican. The agenda was kept current and available in the office of the county clerk. The open meeting act and agenda are posted.

The road supt. Toney Krajewski updated the board on the road project and Champion bridge. The culverts used to replace the bridge will be removed and lengthened to make a wider road.

Brian Prosser joined the meeting at 8:25 a.m. He indicated in the past the Lamar fire has used gas from the county shop for their fire equipment. Their new unit is diesel. They are requesting access to the shop to get access to diesel fuel now. The board agreed to give them a key. Brian left the meeting at 8:30 a.m.

More discussion was held concerning the Champion bridge replacement. Toney left the meeting.

Jacci indicated that Deb Teply would not be attending at 9:00 a.m. as scheduled. This will be continued to a future meeting.

Imperial EMS representatives joined the meeting. More discussion was held concerning their status change to employees for 2023. They now have an EIN as a non-profit. They indicated there is a requirement for us to have life insurance coverage for them. The county will talk to NIRMA.

They do not want the local run payments made to individuals. This was the first month this change was made. After much discussion, the board directed the clerk to cancel those checks that include local runs. New checks will be issued next month for only the transfers.

Deputy county attorney Rory Roundtree asked if there was any formation documentation for Imperial EMS. Deb Hayes indicated she would check their files. The group left at 9:30 a.m.

Duane Dinnel moved to approve the minutes of the August 9th meeting. Dennis Kunnemann seconded. Duane-yes; Dennis-yes; Jacci-yes; motion carried.

The agreement with Brad Foote has not been prepared.

Jacci Brown moved to have Greg Jantz, under Toney Krajewski's direction, fix the Champion bridge. Dennis Kunnemann seconded. Jacci-yes; Dennis-yes; Duane-yes; motion carried.

The Resolution approving preliminary ley request for subdivisions will be acted on at the budget meeting this afternoon.

Hospital board appointment to fill Kim Kunnemann's term was discussed. Several names are being considered. Someone had indicated that Bob Mendenhall wants to retire at the end of his term in March. Duane Dinnel feels Wauneta needs representation on the board. Board appointment will be placed on the next agenda.

Domestic Abuse is unable to attend as scheduled.

Claims list was e-mailed to the board yesterday. Duane Dinnel moved to approve claims for payment with the exception of the 14 Imperial EMS checks that included local runs. Jacci Brown seconded. Duane-yes; Jacci-yes; Dennis-yes; motion carried.
